Dear Parent:

On February 12-14th, 7th graders will participate in an educational program called “**The Best is Worth Waiting For**” as part of the middle school Health curriculum.

The program is part of a county wide, multi-year initiative to bring children age appropriate information about healthy relationships, sexuality and abstinence. The program also fulfills the Ohio Department of Education’s abstinence education requirements.

The 7th grade program focuses on developing healthy relationships, emotional and physical consequences of teen sexual involvement, resisting peer and media influence and the benefits of abstinence.

The program is sponsored by the Teen Pregnancy Prevention Project of the Geauga County Board of Education. TPP also surveys students both before and after the program to determine any positive impact the program has had on their knowledge, opinions and attitudes about sexual behavior.
