Dear Parent:

On January 22-25th and January 29-February 1st, 8th graders will participate in an educational program called “**Ready for the Pressure**” as part of the middle school Health curriculum. Last year 7th graders participated in the first year of the program called “**The Best is Worth Waiting For**”.

These programs are part of a county wide, multi-year initiative sponsored by Geauga Teen Pregnancy Prevention (TPP) that brings children age appropriate information about healthy relationships, sexuality and abstinence. They also fulfill The Ohio Department of Education’s abstinence education requirements.

The 8th grade program focuses on setting personal standards, abstinence planning, decision-making and resistance skills, and understanding the emotional-social and physical risks of teen sexual activity.

The program also features presentations by abstinent high school students who act as role models and offer guidance for the students. 8th graders are also given the second year TPP Student Survey to determine changes to students knowledge, opinions or attitudes regarding sexual behavior.
